SHOW CLASSES: LLAMA AND ALPACA

Halter Classes: Non-breeders and breeding male/female

Non-Breeder: Classes are open to geldings, vasectomized males, and spayed females. This must be documented on Health papers. Classes with less than 3 animals can be combined.

Breeding Classes: If there are fewer than 3 llamas/alpacas in any age division, classes can be combined. Males and females will not be combined.

AGE CLASSIFICATIONS: Alpacas and Llamas

- Juvenile: 5-12 months
- Yearling: 13-24 months
- 2-Year-Old: 25-36 months
- Adult over 36 months

NOTE: On the Llama or Alpaca’s date of birth, the Llama or Alpaca moves up to the next older class. Animal ages for class are computed as of 12/10/21.

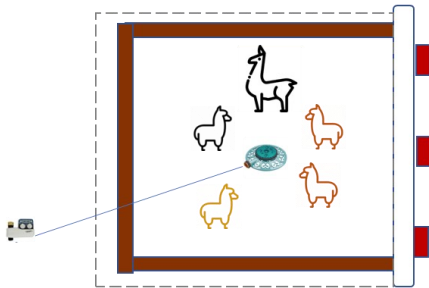

Easy Setup

1. Level the ground
 2. Lay out timbers to form 3 sides and add screws to corners
 3. Lay tarp over timbers and fold underneath them
 4. Place PVC pipe at open end and wrap tarp over it
 5. Add bricks next to pipe
 6. Attached sprinkler to hose (not included in cost)
 7. Add hose to timer and turn on.
- NOTE: You can make pool larger by adding more timbers and increasing size of tarp.
I highly recommend heavy duty tarp, especially if you have llamas
